The Internal Affairs Section of the Parsippany-Troy Hills Police Department (PTHPD) has completed its investigation of your complaint concerning the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) requests made by you to the PTHPD on July [REDACTED].

The investigation revealed that the PTHPD violated its policy and procedures, and did not comply with the *New Jersey Attorney General Internal Affairs Policy and Procedures* (aka *Guidelines*), when it failed to release the reports you requested.

Kindly find attached to this letter the reports you requested from the PTHPD on July [REDACTED]. The reports being provided to you contain updated statistics and information. In the related OPRA requests, you also requested the dates the reports were released to the public. The PTHPD was required to make the reports available to the public, and erred when it failed to release them at your request. Prior to July [REDACTED], no other requests for the reports are known to have been made by a member of the public, therefore the reports had not been released as of that date. Accordingly, the dates you are seeking are not available.
