2020 Road Resurfacing / Curb & Sidewalk Program

The project is being prepared for bidding. The list of streets to be resurfaced will be finalized by the end of March. (**No Council Action Required**).

Greenbank Road Safety and Improvements Project

The Greenbank Road Improvement Project was bid in February and is on the agenda for award. Construction activities are planned to begin in April and will continue through the end of July. (A Resolution will need to be adopted by the Township Council).

Various Streets Reconstruction Project

The Various Streets Reconstruction Project was bid in February and is on the agenda for award. This project includes reconstruction of Cottage Place, Prospect Avenue, James Street and John Street off Park Road. Construction Activities are planned to begin in April and will continue through the end of August. (A Resolution will need to be adopted by the Township Council).

Roadway Design Projects

The following projects are in design; New England Drive Area Street and Drainage Improvements, Mt. Tabor Street Improvements- Phase V, Puddingstone Heights Road Improvements, and the Various Culvert Repair Project. These projects will be bid once design documents are finalized and construction will start in the summer. (No Council Action Required).

Community Rating System (CRS) Program

Letters have been mailed to various homeowners whose houses do not comply with the National Flood Insurance Program requirements in an effort to bring them into compliance. We continue to work with our consultant and the NJDEP to getting back into the CRS program. This program provides discounts on flood insurance policies based on the level of activities in which the Township participates. This work will continue through at least the end of this year. (No Council Action Required).

Performance Bond Release – Mazdabrook Farms, Ph. I Block 735 Lot 1

The developer completed all site work in accordance with the approved plans. Inspections were made during the course of construction and this office has no objection to the release of Performance Bond No. 0371144. (A Resolution will need to be adopted by the Township Council).

<u>Performance Bond Release – Paul Miller Jaguar Land Rover Block 693 Lot 9</u>

The developer completed all site work in accordance with the approved plans. Inspections were made during the course of construction and this office has no objection to the release of Performance Surety Bond No. 8253-04-52. (A Resolution will need to be adopted by the Township Council).

Route 46 / Vail Road Traffic Signal Upgrade Agreement

The Township has asked the NJDOT to upgrade the traffic signal at Route 46 and Vail Road to provide safer pedestrian access across Route 46. The NJDOT requires that the Township formally request this upgrade and agree to pay 25% of the cost of the improvements. This office recommends entering into this agreement to improve pedestrian safety while crossing Route 46. (A Resolution will need to be adopted by the Township Council).

Major Soil Moving Permit – 1719 Route 10 LP, Block 200 Lot 1

The Board of Adjustment has recommended approval of a major soil moving permit in conjunction with the site plan application at 1719 Route 10. This office has reviewed the application and recommends the Township Council approve the permit. (We recommend the Township Council approve the permit by resolution).
