# **Greenbank Road Safety and Improvements Project**

## Mt. Tabor Street Improvements, Phase V

### **Roadway Design Projects**

The following projects are in design: Puddingstone Heights Road Improvements, Various Culvert Repair Project, Mt. Tabor Street Improvements, Ph VI, Edwards Road Improvements, Baldwin Road Pedestrian Accessibility Improvements and the 2021 Road Resurfacing and Sidewalk Repair Project.
