Greenbank Road Safety and Improvements Project

Roadway Design Projects

The following projects are in design; Puddingstone Heights Road Improvements and the Various Culvert Repair Project. These projects will be bid once design documents are finalized. (No Council Action Required).

Community Rating System (CRS) Program

We continue to work with our consultant and the NJDEP to get back into the CRS program. This program provides discounts on flood insurance policies based on the level of activities in which the Township participates. The work will continue through at least the end of this year. Stop signs were requested at Canton Road and Florham Road at their intersections with Flemington Drive.
